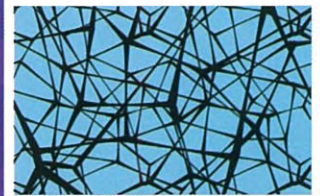

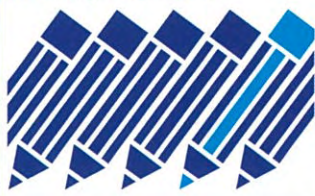

Course aims

Participants will:

- Learn how to transform research into articles that can be published in scholarly journals, from drafting, editing, and revising their work with the guidance of instructor feedback and peer review.
- Produce an article ready for submission to a scholarly journal over the course of the program.

Who is the course for?

University Lecturers or anyone who wants help with writing an article to be submitted to a scholarly journal for publication

Entry requirements

A minimum English level of IELTS 6.0; TOEFL IBT 80 or PTE 56. Ideally, participants would also already have completed their research, and now want help with producing their article.

Course Structure

The course will be a one-week (25 hours over 5 days) face-to-face in a class group, and then three months working together online with your tutor. During the online phase you will be working on various tasks, with feedback from and consultation with your tutor.

Face-to-face at IALF Jakarta: 15 - 19 January 2018

Three months online: 22 January - 14 April 2018
