Do not read.

Tolong is used when you ask someone to do something for your benefit or a third party's benefit. For example:

- *Tolong baca!* (Please read)
- *Tolong tulis!* (Please write)

Silakan is used when you ask someone to do something for their own benefit. For example you say to a guest at your house:

- *Silakan duduk!* (Please sit down)
- *Silakan minum!* (Please drink)
