## Program

The IALF offers a two-week intensive course in Bahasa Indonesia which is suitable for absolute beginners as well as those who can manage just a few words. The course has been designed for those who have recently arrived and therefore includes information on cross-cultural issues.

The course begins with topics such as introductions and greetings, times and dates, numbers and prices, and builds up to simple everyday exchanges. Other topics include identifying objects, shopping, talking about locations and directions, routines, family and health.

The morning session is four hours and the afternoon session is two hours. There is an emphasis on active participation by the students. Activities often include extended practice in pairs or small groups.

Language work is consolidated through an optional visit to a market, where students have the opportunity to use classroom language in an authentic context.

## Teachers

Instructors are experienced native-speaker teachers of Indonesian as a Foreign Language. All hold a university degree and teaching qualification, and understand the types of difficulties experienced by adult second-language learners. Though they will teach primarily through the medium of Indonesian, all are fluent speakers of English.

## Facilities

The IALF training and resource centre, features:

- Fully equipped air-conditioned classrooms
- Student library with Indonesian section
- Computer lab with a CD-ROM program for learning Bahasa Indonesia
- Audio-visual self-access centre
- Language laboratory

## Schedule

The program runs from 8.00 - 15.00, Monday to Friday for two weeks, a total of sixty hours.
